Just a polite reminder that breakfast club currently starts at 8.30 am so your child must not be left prior to this time, thank you.

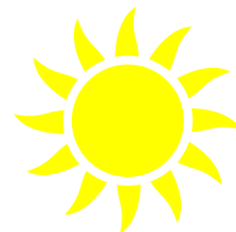
Polite notice:
